

SHENANDOAH MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS CODE

Shenandoah Middle School is a **mandatory** uniform school. The dress code was established in order to set safety measures in place and the tone for an academic atmosphere in which students and faculty can function without distraction.

CLOTHING	REQUIREMENTS
SHIRTS	SOLID BLACK, GREY, AND PURPLE POLO SHIRTS ONLY Must extend beyond the waist.
UNDERSHIRTS	SOLID BLACK, GREY OR PURPLE ONLY Cannot exceed the length of the polo shirt. Can only be worn under the polo shirt.
PANTS	SOLID BLACK OR BEIGE (KHAKI) PANTS ONLY (CANNOT BE FORM-FITTING "SKINNY") May not have patches or holes. NO shorts, skirts, sweatpants, tights or leggings.
SHOES	MUST HAVE BACKS. No slippers, sandals, flip-flops, crocs or shoes with make shift straps.
ID'S	STUDENT ID'S Once distributed, school issued identification cards MUST be always worn at all times.

The following items MAY NOT BE WORN:

- NO** shorts, sweatpants, tights, or leggings.
- NO** t-shirts (the only t-shirts allowed will be **school issued** club and athletic t-shirts in school colors & must have Shenandoah/Chiefs logo).
- NO** sagging pants. Pants must be worn at their original length and fitted at the waist with no visible undergarments.
- NO** strapless shoes, flip flop type shoes, crocs or shoes with make-shift/temporary straps.
- NO** hats or hoods may be worn in any building or classroom.
- NO** headwear of any kind: headbands, mesh head coverings, bandanas, handkerchiefs, do-rags, hair curlers, combs, and hair picks. These items **MAY NOT** be brought to school.
- NO** sleep wear, bedroom shoes, pajamas, or slippers.
- NO** dog collars, motorcycle chains, two or three finger rings, or spikes.
- NO** colors, symbols, national pendants or items associated with gangs (this includes bandanas and flags made with beads).
- NO** trench coats.
- NO** sunglasses may be worn in the building.

DRESS CODE POLICY ENFORCEMENT

If a student is not in the appropriate dress, they will be sent to the grade level administrator and will be issued the appropriate consequences.
